ausiliare **be** + aggiunta di **ing** alla forma base del verbo

eat → **eating**

read → **reading**

Alcuni verbi eliminano la **e** prima di aggiungere **ing**

ride → **riding**

write → **writing**

Altri raddoppiano la consonante finale prima di aggiungere **ing**

swim → **swimming**

sit → **sitting**
